'Positive signs' at miner's iron prospect

Mining company Carpentaria Exploration says its Hawson's iron prospect, 60 kilometres south of Broken Hill in far-west New South Wales, has produced encouraging results.

The company recently completed comprehensive mapping and rock sampling in the area.

Carpentaria's executive chairman Nick Sheard says more work is needed on the extent of mineralisation in the area, but the results so far are positive.

The project area is covered by two exploration tenements and one is jointly owned by Carpentaria and Perilya.
